Library as learning resource

The college library stands as a cornerstone of academic support, catering to the diverse needs of our student body and faculty. Operating from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm on all working days, including Saturdays and vacations, our library ensures accessibility for all members of our community.

With an extensive collection comprising 38,723 books, 33 journals, 10 periodicals, and 12 dailies, our library comprehensively meets academic requirements, including specialized materials for competitive examinations.

Utilizing KOHA library automation software (version 23.05.06.00), our library ensures efficient cataloging, data entry, circulation, and stock verification. Integration with the INFLIBNET N-LIST consortium expands access to e-books and e-journals, accessible both within the library and remotely through individual login credentials. The INFLIBNET arena, equipped with ten computers, further enhances accessibility to digital resources. The library provides Braille systems and resources to support visually challenged students in their academic pursuits.

In addition to traditional services, our library conducts orientation programs for new students and maintains distinct sections, including Circulation, Periodical, Reference, General Reading, and Stack Room. Automated book lending, reference assistance, journal subscriptions, and access to N-LIST resources exemplify our commitment to academic enrichment.

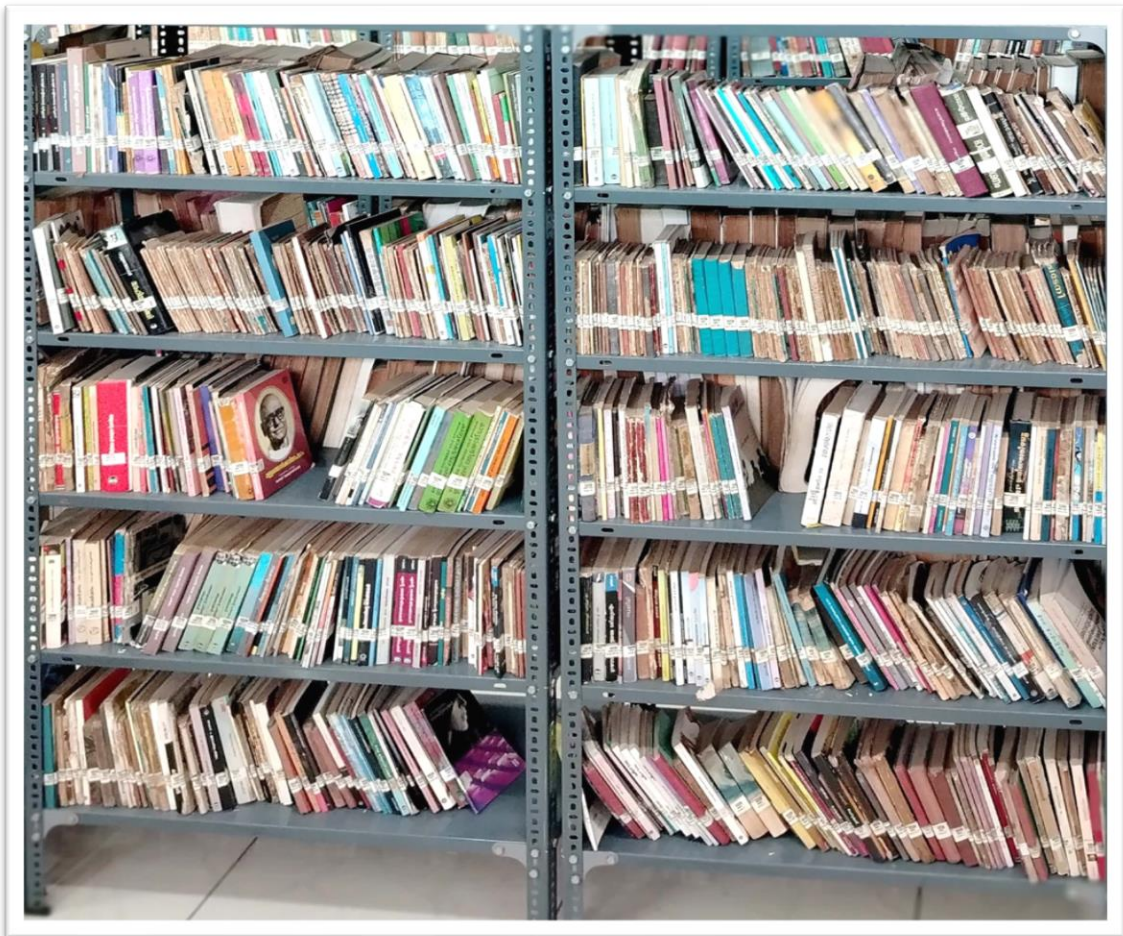
